

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



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Thesis Statements for Argument Essays

A thesis statement for an argument essay must clearly state the writer's position on a real issue. It should not be a personal opinion that cannot be proven, like "Popcorn is more delicious than peanuts." It often includes a word or phrase that signals an opinion (should, ought to, need to, have an obligation to, must). In addition, it may include phrases such as, "for a number of reasons" and "because of several factors," that preview the reasons to be discussed. The most explicit thesis statement states the reasons the writer will use to support her argument. Study these examples:

Poor: Cigarette smoking in public places is not a very good idea.

(Does not clearly state what the writer's position actually is.)

Good: Cigarette smoking in public places **should be banned**.

(States clearly what the writer's position actually is.)

Better: Cigarette smoking in public places should be banned because of several


important reasons.

(Mentions that there are reasons to support the writer's position.)

Best: Cigarette smoking in public places should be banned because of the health

dangers it presents to not only smokers but also to people around them.

(Includes the writer's reasons.)

II STAGE: FINAL ESSAY (TEST) & TEACHER'S FEEDBACK (SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT)







Assessment by Criteria

1. Z Task Fulfilment and Content (17/25)

- Strengths:
 - The essay clearly addresses the prompt and offers a central guiding question.
 - Real-life and hypothetical scenarios are used to explore moral reasoning and legality.
- · Areas for Improvement:

- The thesis is implied but not clearly stated in the final sentence of the introduction, as required.
- The essay lacks a strong argumentative structure. It feels more like a set of moral musings than a firmly positioned stance.
- The conclusion defers judgment rather than restating a clear thesis or providing a persuasive closing argument.

Suggestions:

Include a clear thesis statement such as:
 While laws are essential to societal order, they must sometimes be broken in cases where moral obligations strongly outweigh legal constraints.

2. V Organization, Structure, Transitions (15/25)

- · Strengths:
 - Logical flow of thought using examples from daily life.
- Issues:
 - Weak topic sentences and transitions between paragraphs.
 - The third body paragraph introduces a counterargument, but no clear refutation is provided.
 - The conclusion lacks an explicit transition (e.g., "In conclusion...") and does not restate the thesis.

Suggestions:

- Begin each paragraph with a stronger topic sentence.
- Add clearer transitional phrases between paragraphs (e.g., Another example that raises questions of legality and morality is...).
- Structure the counterargument paragraph using a clearer contrast like:
 Some might argue that... However...

👊 1. Argument and Counterargument Structure

Argument 1 (Paragraph 2):

"In simple situations, it would be justifiable action. For example, if a leash with a dog at the end is tied to a train track..."

- Strength: The example is vivid and morally relevant.
- X Issue: The idea is not explicitly connected to a broader claim or thesis.
- Suggestion: Lead with a clear topic sentence like:
 In certain life-threatening situations, breaking the law can be morally justified if it preserves life or prevents serious harm.

4. Grammar, Spelling, and Syntax (12/25)

- Common Errors:
 - Verb agreement and sentence fragments:
 "Even if it's extremely dangerous to others around you." → sentence fragment.
 - Spelling: "peoples morals" → people's morals, "shops management" → the store's management
 - Articles and determiners often missing: "a potential thief", "the rails", "a law"
 - Inconsistent punctuation, especially missing commas after introductory phrases.

Suggestions:

- · Proofread carefully for run-ons, fragments, and missing articles.
- . Use a grammar checker or peer review to spot frequent patterns of error.

Key Improvements Needed:

- Add a clearly worded thesis statement at the end of the introduction with a modal verb (e.g., must, should).
- Strengthen structure: two arguments, one counterargument + refutation, then conclusion.
- Improve academic tone: remove second-person pronouns (you), contractions (it's), and colloquial
 phrases.
- · Proofread for grammar, punctuation, and awkward sentence constructions.




